### Things to keep in mind

Whenever we talk about somebody's appearance we must use the question:

**“What do you look like? What does he/she look like?”**

If a person isn't short he/she is **tall** not **high**.

If he/she isn't **fat**, he/she is **slim** or thin and not **skinny** (which has a negative meaning).

When asking about somebody's hair and eyes (kind and colour) we can use the questions: **What colour hair/ eyes have you got (has she/ he got)? What kind of hair have you got (has she/he got)?**
